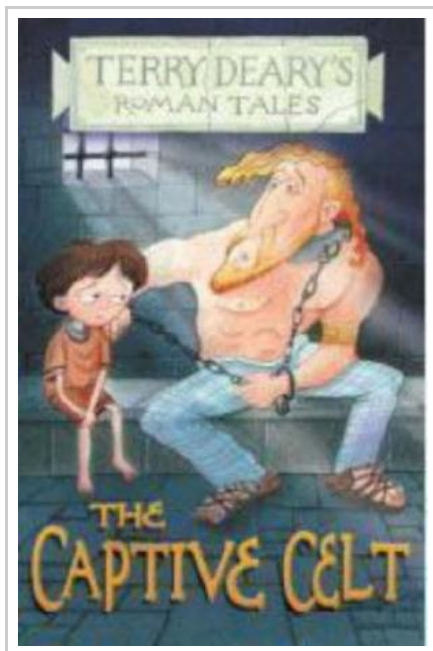




The Captive Celt
