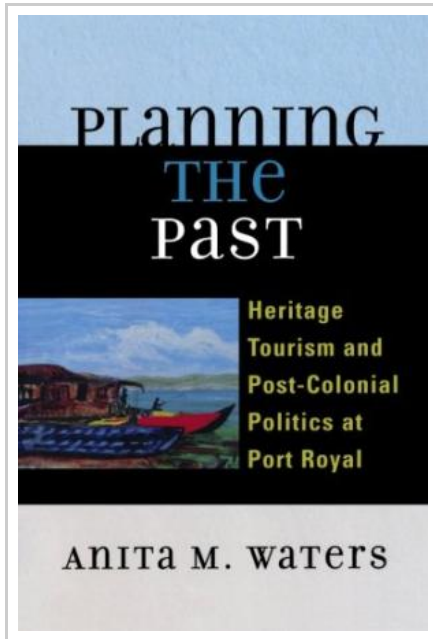




Planning the Past: Heritage Tourism and Post-colonial Politics at Port Royal
